Community Base Work Experience

Community Base Work Experience (CBWE) is a program that was developed for individuals with disabilities to volunteer in the community to learn work related skills. The Pre-Employment Transition Specialist collaborates with the local hospital to place students in a real life work environment to learn skills needed for jobs. At Monroe County Hospital students rotate through three different experiences or jobs which may include one of the following: Environmental Services, Materials Management, Clerical, Nutrition, and Maintenance. Students are evaluated by employees and staff at the hospital and then are given their evaluations to review with the Pre-Employment Transition Specialist.
